Oklahoma City HR Partners Recognized for Professional Certification

Oklahoma City, OK - June 3, 2004 – At a recent national conference held by the Society for Human Resource Management (SHRM), Oklahoma State University – Oklahoma City (OSUOKC) and the Oklahoma City Human Resource Society (OCHRS) were recognized for their outstanding success in preparing local human resource professionals for national certification. Out of 220 nationwide certification preparation programs represented, the Oklahoma City program was one of only nine, nationwide, that achieved a 100% pass rate for the Professional in Human Resources (PHR) and Senior Professional in Human Resources (SPHR) certification examinations.
